- DBDT’s headquarters, built in 1930 as the Moorland YMCA, retains historical significance as one of only three remaining buildings in downtown Dallas constructed by and for the African-American community to serve as a social, civic, and cultural center.
- Located at the eastern end of the thriving downtown Dallas Arts District, 2700 Flora Street is now the permanent home of DBDT’s rehearsal studios, training classrooms, and administrative offices.
